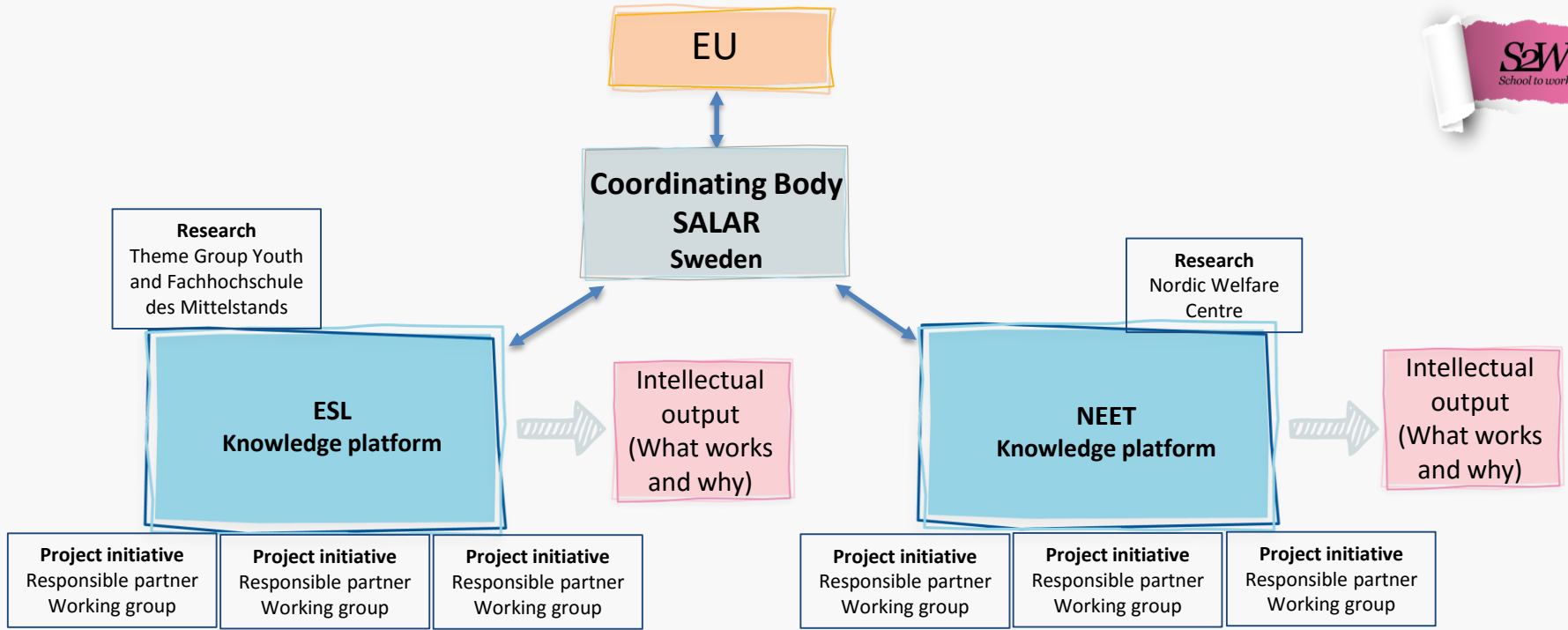

A collaboration between Gdansk, Sopot, Gdynia (POL), Bromölla (SWE) and Tartu (EST)

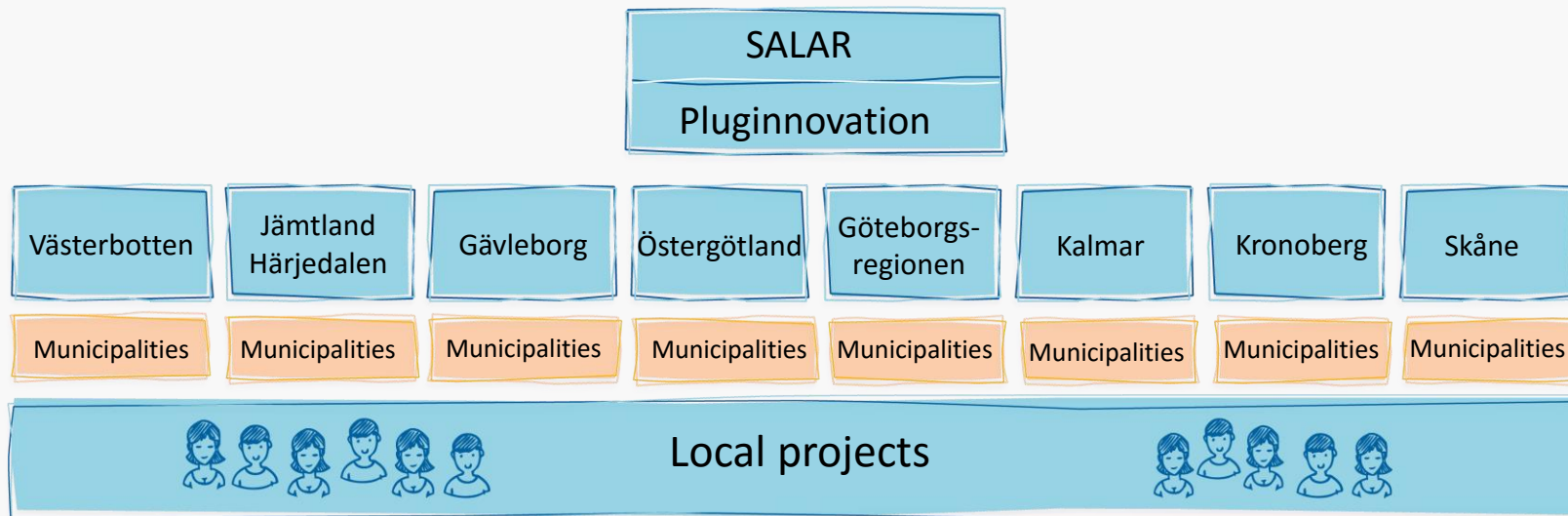
Will prepare three projects, one in each of the three countries targeting ESF and bridging them with the help of the so called transnational component.

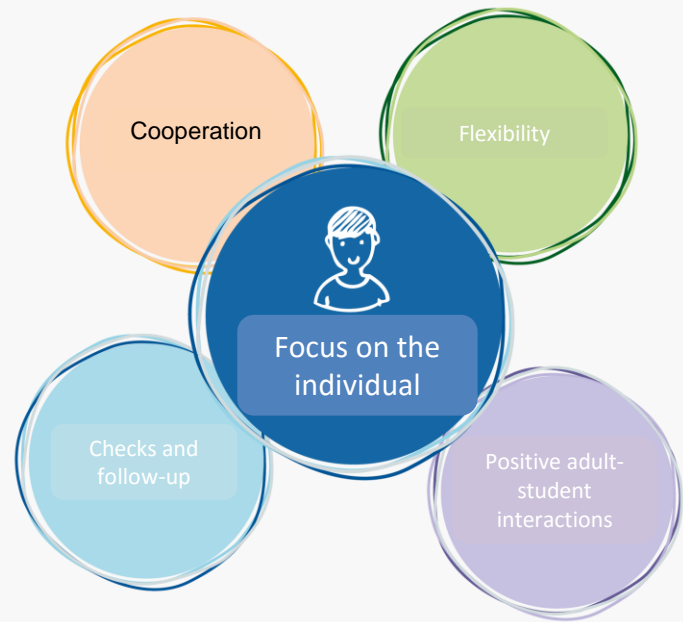
